ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING

The alternate side parking winter period shall be from and including November 1 through and including March 31. City Code requires that when parking on any public roadway between 1AM and 6AM (early morning hours) park on the even-numbered side of any public roadway on even-numbered days and the odd-numbered side of any public roadway on odd-numbered days. Violators may be fined and/or towed. Alternate side parking regulations apply regardless of weather conditions. Alternate side parking regulations do not apply to those streets in which parking is allowed on one side only. AQUATIC CENTER

The Aquatic Center is open from June through mid-August and provides a variety of swimming activities for the entire family. CITY UTILITIES

The City provides electric, water, sewer, stormwater, garbage, recycling, and street lighting service to most residential households. Bills are mailed by the 1st of the month and are due by the 10th of the month.

The City of Caledonia currently accepts cash, checks, money orders, automatic account withdrawal, debit and credit cards, and online bill pay. Any credit transaction is subject to a 2% convenience fee.

Payments may be mailed to 231 E. Main St. or dropped off in the drop box located at City Hall. If mailing your payment, please allow 3-5 business days for your payment to be received. A late fee will be applied to a payment received after the 10th of each month.

In order to stop or start utility service, please stop by City Hall during regular business hours. Renters are required to provide a \$250 utility deposit and landlords must sign a services agreement with the City.

DUMPSTERS

No garbage shall be disposed of in a business dumpster, except by the business itself. Violators will be fined. Dumpsters are only for the use of the business that pays for them. For dumpsters being used for construction or personal use, dumpsters must be placed on the property and not in the City streets.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

The Caledonia Economic Development Authority was established in 1992 and exists to support local businesses, attract new businesses, and promote the economic climate in the City

of Caledonia. The EDA and City offer a variety of financial incentives for both new and existing businesses, including low-interest loans, commercial rehabilitation loans (façade improvement), tax abatement, and tax-increment financing. FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Caledonia Fire Department was established in 1889 and has a Class 4 ISO rating. The department's members are ready 24 hours a day, 365 days a year and respond to approximately 40 calls each year. Every October members participate in Fire Prevention Week, providing fire safety information to elementary school students. The department is always accepting applications for those interested in becoming a firefighter.

GARBAGE & RECYLING COLLECTION

Curbside pickup of garbage is every Monday at 6:00 am. If Monday falls on a state or federal holiday, then garbage is picked up on Tuesday. Garbage must be put into garbage totes provided. Check the City website for details.



Recycled items should be put in the recycling totes provided and placed at the curb by 6:00 am for pick up. Recycled items are picked up every other week. Check the City website for a schedule.

Recyclable items include: glass bottles/jars; metal cans; plastic bottles/jars; paper, newsprint, junk mail, magazines and boxboard (cereal, chip, cake boxes, etc.) and corrugated cardboard.

To prepare recyclables, remove caps/lids, rinse cans, bottles, and jars; there is no need to remove labels. No plastic bags or Styrofoam. Flatten cardboard and paper board.

PET LICENSE & LEASH ORDINANCE

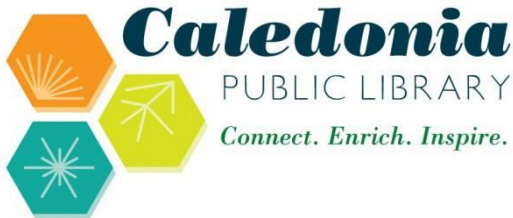
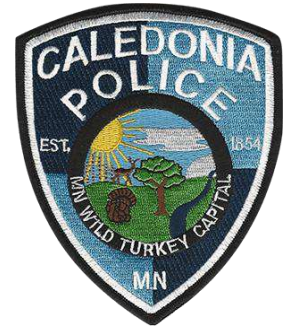
All dogs and cats are required to be licensed. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required before any license is issued. There is a \$10.00 per animal fee for a license. There is a \$2.00 discount if your pet is spayed or neutered. You can purchase your pet license at the Caledonia Police Department. Private ownership cannot exceed three of either species.



Every owner or keeper of any animal shall keep such animal upon the premises of such owner or keeper, or secured by a leash. A fine plus boarding will be charged to the owner of any animal found at large. Proof of rabies vaccination will be required before the animal is released to the owner. The Caledonia Police Department prides itself on being a community-oriented department. They work closely with youth and City residents to ensure the future and safety of the Caledonia area. PUBLIC LIBRARY

The Caledonia Public Library offers thousands of books, magazines, DVDs, and more. They also have a local history section, including a microfilm collection of past Caledonia newspapers. They offer regular programming to our patrons, from birth to adulthood. The library is also connected with SELCO, one of Minnesota's 12 regional public library systems. They have access to over 3.5 million items within the system and even more statewide.

PUBLIC WORKS

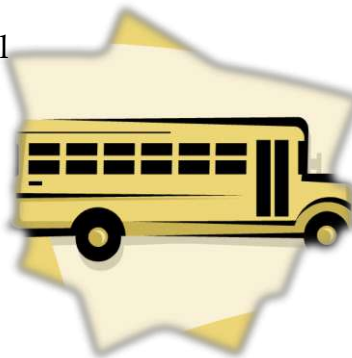
The City of Caledonia Public Works Department maintains City water, streets, sewer services, storm drainage, street lighting, and parks and recreation facilities.

TREE DISPOSAL SITE

Yard waste may be disposed of at the City's tree disposal site. Yard waste must be contained

within biodegradable paper bags. No plastic bags are permitted. The Tree Disposal Site is open from April 1 – November 1. There is no fee to use the tree disposal site for City residents.

Directions: Take County Road east of Caledonia, then turn right onto County Road 32.

PARKS

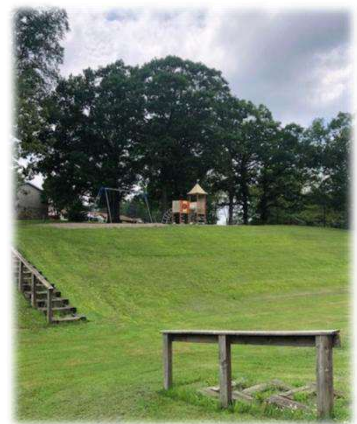
The City of Caledonia offers a variety of parks and recreational opportunities within the community, enabling residents to take advantage of the natural amenities that are available in the area.



Veterans Memorial Recreational Area: The park is located in the northern portion of Caledonia and contains a number of different facilities, including both a baseball and softball field, a pickleball court, concession stand, aquatic center, three shelters, lighted basketball court, 3 large play sets that serve different age groups, 6 pieces of free-standing equipment, and restrooms.

North Park: The park contains 2 shelters, restrooms, 2 pieces of play equipment, and the Earthwalkers Memorial display. North Park is used in the winter as a sledding park. The park also contains the seasonal signs, flags, and flowers that welcome visitors entering the community from the east on State Highways 76 and 44.

Gazebo Park: The park contains a gazebo, picnic tables, and two pieces of play equipment. Given its central location immediately adjacent to the downtown, this park serves as a focal point for a number of community activities including Music in the Park, Children's Fun Fest, Founder's Day, readings from the library, and an occasional petting zoo.



South Park: The park is located on Adams Street in the southernmost portion of the community. South Park contains a shelter with picnic tables, benches, and two pieces of play equipment.



Sprague Woods: It is an approximately 8-acre wooded parcel located at the intersection of State Highways 76 and 44. This parcel was donated to the City in 2006 and has a walking trail.

Pocket Park: The pocket park is located in downtown Caledonia. The park consists of an 8' x 48' mural depicting natural scenery and wildlife. Included in the park are benches for relaxing and a picnic table is available for dining.

Other Parks: The public elementary school facility located at 511 W. Main St. in the center of the Caledonia community offers a large open space with basketball courts and soccer fields. The school grounds also offer four pieces of play equipment that receive use by students and the general public.

The Caledonia Middle/High School Complex has a 1-mile walking trail around the complex that includes views of prairie grasses and flowers.



ZONING APPLICATION
