

How To Identify Your Water Service Pipe Material

Tools you may need: Screwdriver, Magnet, Penny

Step 1: Locate your water meter. Likely in basement or mechanical room.



Step 2: Find your water service line. This is the line that is connected to the water meter and comes through the floor or wall from the outside.

Step 3: Scratch the surface of the pipe. Use screwdriver or other tool to scratch through and paint or corrosion that may Have built up on the outside of the pipe.

Step 4: Use the pictures below to determine your pipe material.



Galvanized

Scratch Test: The pipe does not scratch easily Copper Scratch Test: The scratched area is copper color, like a penny.

Magnet Test:

Plastic

No need to scratch Plastic can be various colors; white, blue, Black, green, etc.

Magnet Test:

Magnet does not stick Magnet does not stick

Lead

Scratch Test: The pipe is easily scratched and the area is shiny and silver.

Magnet Test:

Magnet does not stick

and remains dull gray.

Magnet Sticks
