CALL TO ORDER: Following due call and notice thereof, Mayor Schroeder called the meeting to order at 3:03 p.m. in the Council Room of City Hall.

NEW BUSINESS:

a. <u>Application by Caledonia Dugout Club, Inc. for exempt permit to hold gambling event</u>: The Council members reviewed an application by the Caledonia Dugout Club, Inc. for an exempt permit to hold a gambling event on April 1, 2017 at MAAD Alley Bowling Center. Member Burns moved to approve the application. Member Lemke seconded the motion. All members present voted in favor of the motion, and the motion passed.
