**Resolution Approving Access to Minnesota Court Data Services for
the City of Caledonia on behalf of the Prosecuting Attorney**

WHEREAS, the City of Caledonia desires to improve efficiencies through participating in a more efficient court process with the Minnesota Judicial Branch; and

WHEREAS, as the Minnesota Judicial Branch moves towards a more efficient court process, the eCourtMN initiative is committed to ensuring that non-court governmental agencies have appropriate access to court records and documents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Caledonia desires to subscribe to Minnesota Court Data Services Program on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney and Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Caledonia, Minnesota as follows:


1. That the City of Caledonia approves and authorizes DeWayne Schroeder, Mayor, to sign the Master Subscriber Agreement for Minnesota Court Data Services for Governmental Agencies on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney and Police Department. A copy of the Master Subscriber Agreement is attached to this Resolution and made a part of it.

2. That the Chief of Police, Kurt Zehnder, or his successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Police Department. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the Minnesota Judicial Branch to maintain the City's connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.


3. That the City Attorney, Alexander C. Roverud, or his successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Prosecuting Attorney. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the Minnesota Judicial Branch to maintain the City's connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.
